Congratulations to Elvia for being elected secretary to the CSEA union. Here is a picture of Elvia introducing herself to the board.

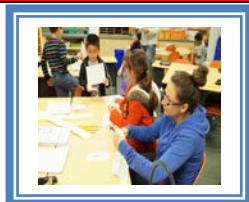


Data Meetings
