Common Core

As we all know the American Education process is changing, a change that has never been seen before in the history of the United States. We are making a huge paradigm shift; no longer should we be happy with our students' ability to regurgitate information that we have spoon-fed them. Students are now being given the opportunity to "think"; to solve problems in a variety of ways, to look beyond simple comprehension of text, to be able to explain their thought process.

In Pathways to the Common Core by Lucy Calkins, Mary Ehrenworth, and Christopher Lehmann explain that one of the strengths of the Common Core document is that there are "grade level benchmarks and a trajectory of skill development" (p.11). As we work with our students we need to remember this and that growth takes time. It is because of the spiral curriculum within the CCSS that teachers K-12 now share the responsibility for students' progress along the trajectory of skill development. As we plan for lessons we need to remember that the Common Core State Standards curriculum and the materials that we adopt to use in our classrooms are the tools we use ensure benchmarks are met and students continue to demonstrate progress in skill development.
